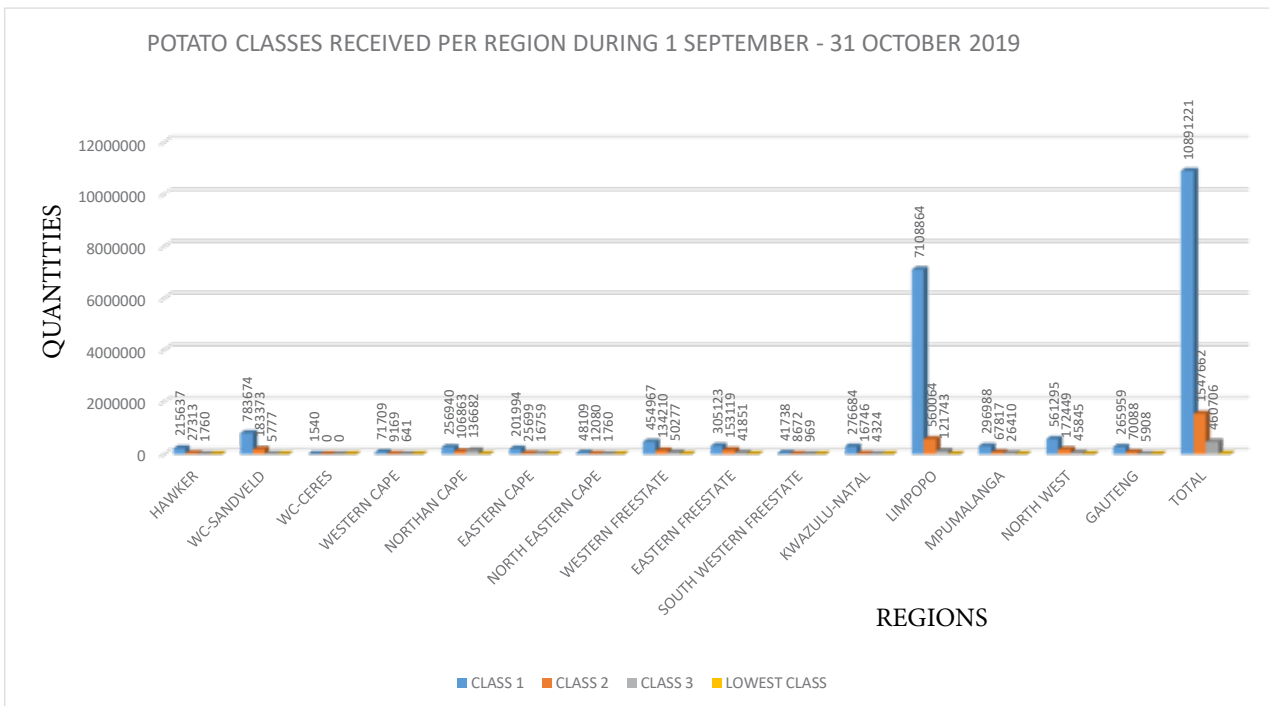
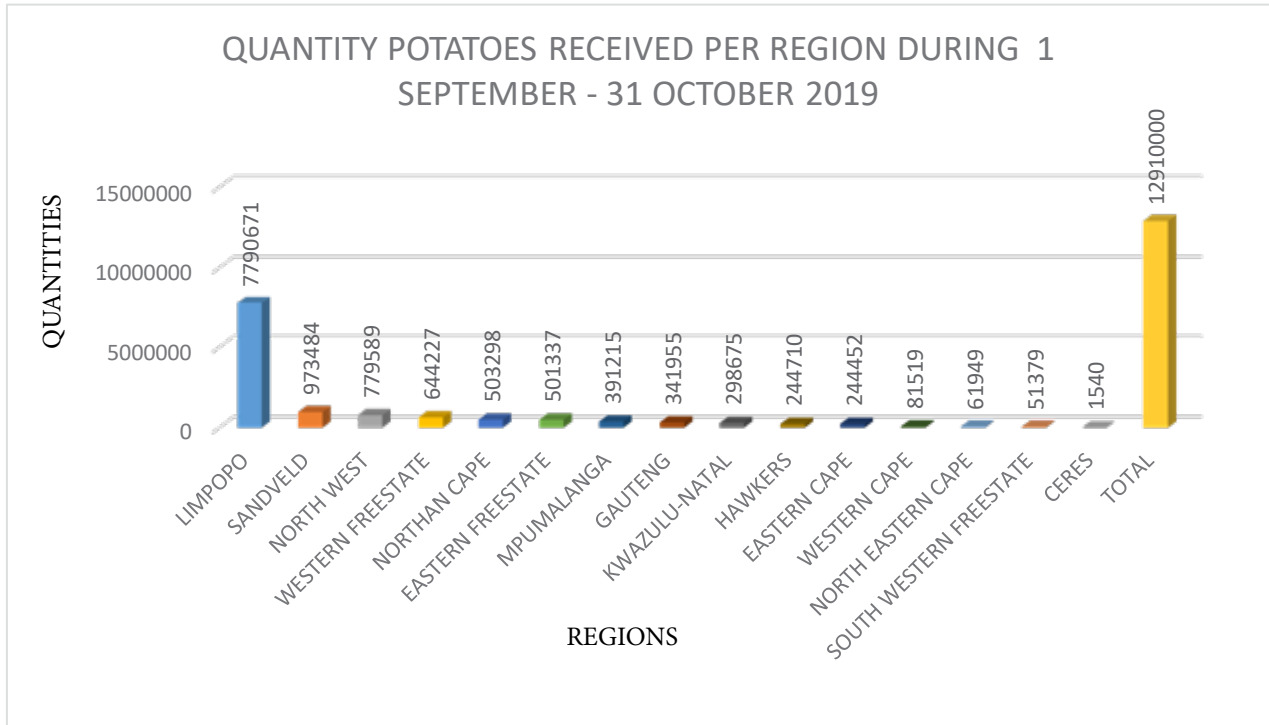
- 12 910 000 bags from 15 regions as well as non-producing suppliers were delivered.

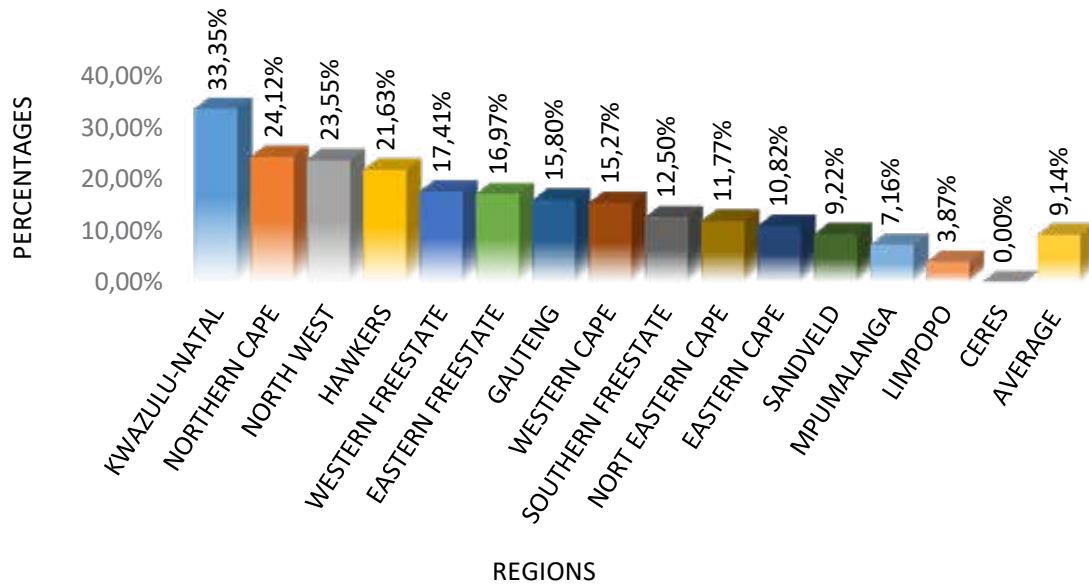

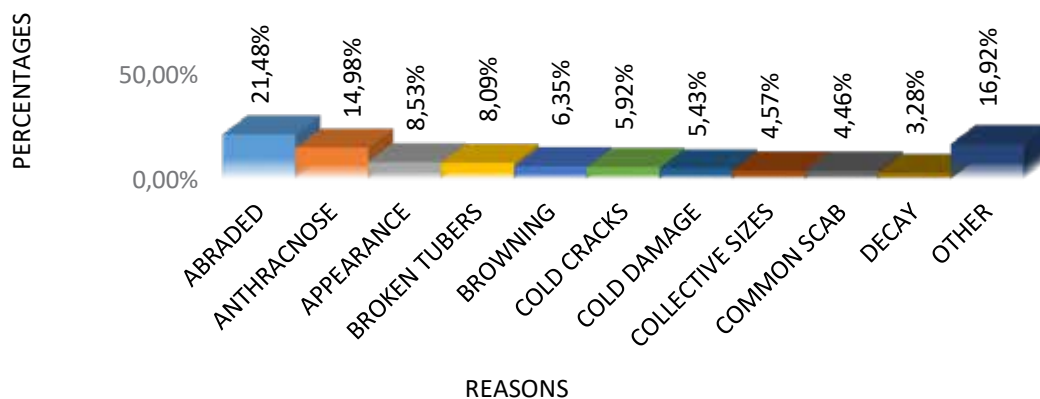

## POTATOES DEGRADED PER REGION DURING 1 SEPTEMBER - 31 OCTOBER 2019

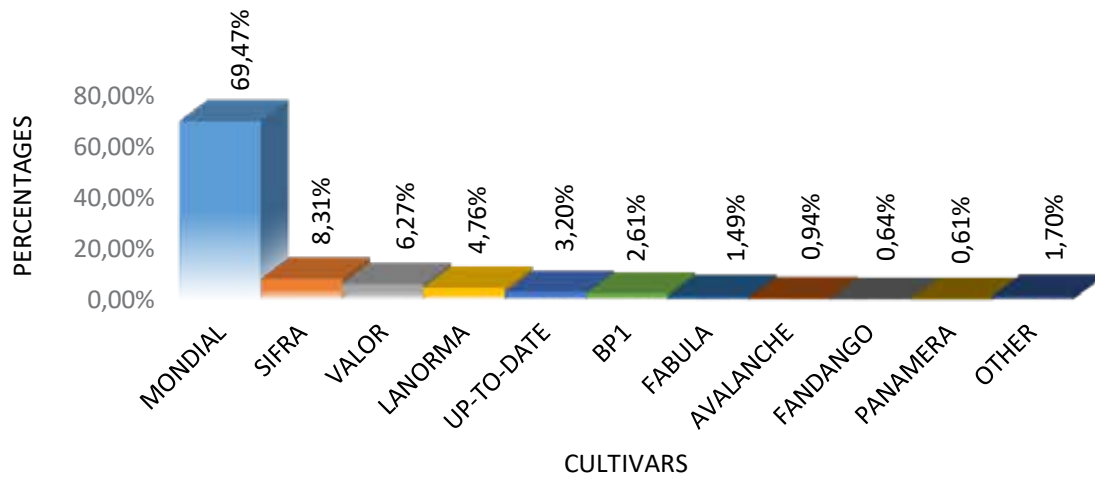


## TOP 10 REASONS FOR DEGRADING PER REGION DURING 1 SEPTEMBER - 31 OCTOBER 2019



Other reasons include: Dry rot, Eelworm, Enlarged lenticels, Glassiness, Greening, Growth cracks, Heat damage, Holl heart, Insect damage, Internal brown fleck, Malformed, Mechanical damage, Potato tuber moth, Powdery scab, Rhizoctonia, Seed stems and sprout, Silver scab, Soiled, Soiled by decay, Sprouted, Stem end rot, To big, To small,
