During September - October 2018, 12 potato production regions as well as non-producing suppliers delivered potatoes nationally to the fresh produce markets.

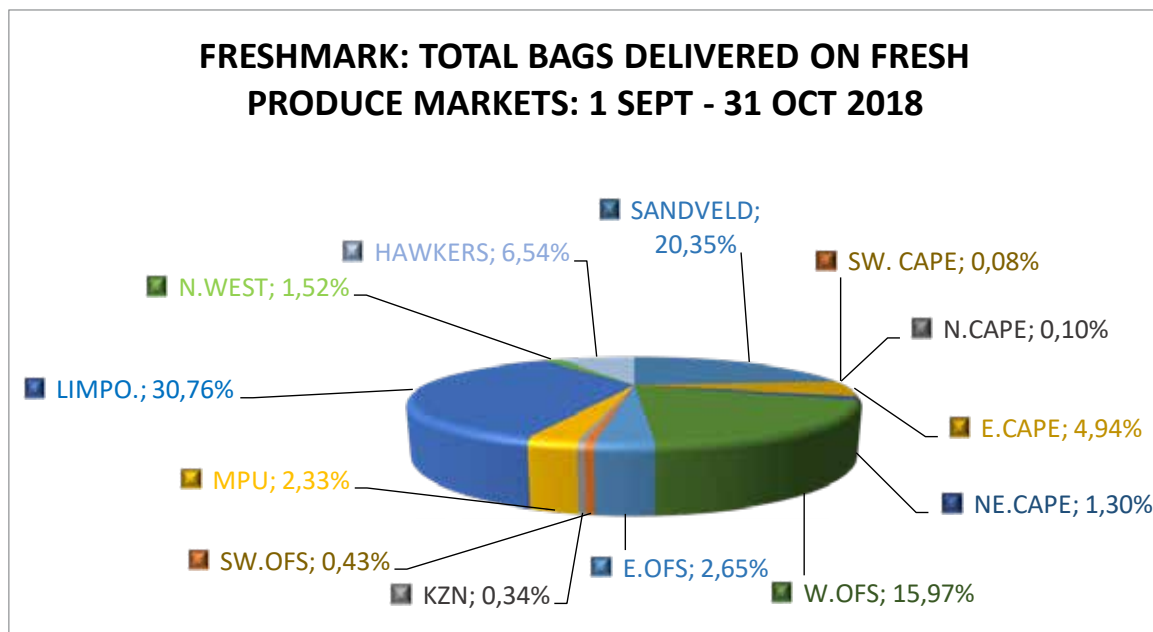

This will enable us to create and provide a greater variety of statistics to industry role players such as Potatoes South Africa and the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries.

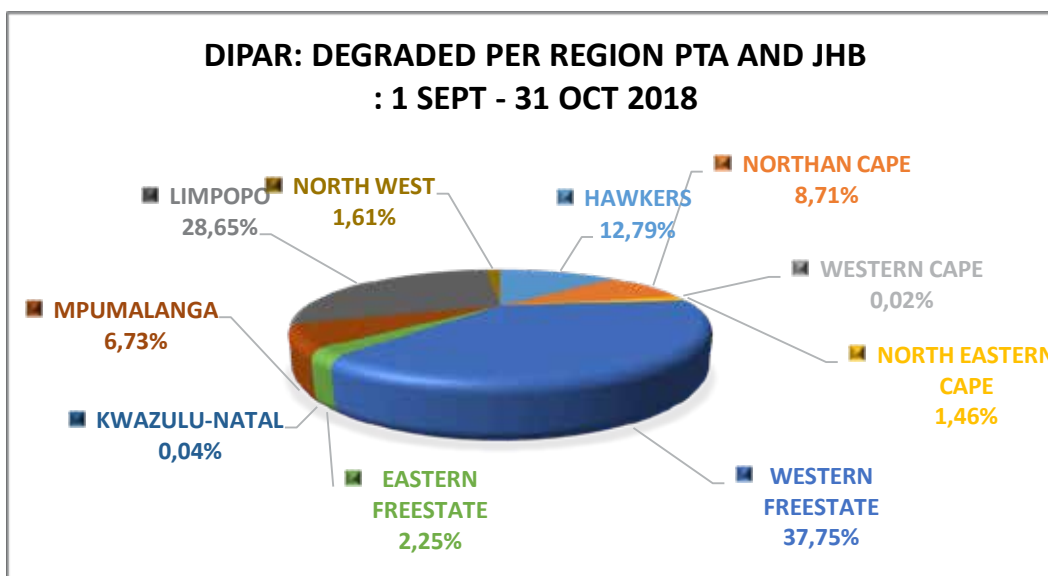
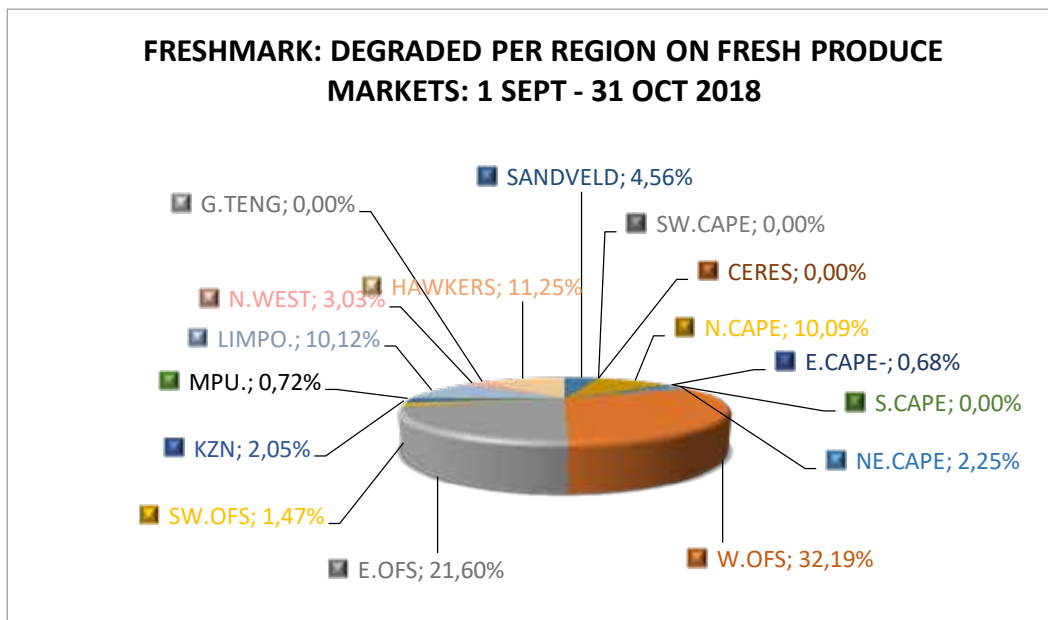
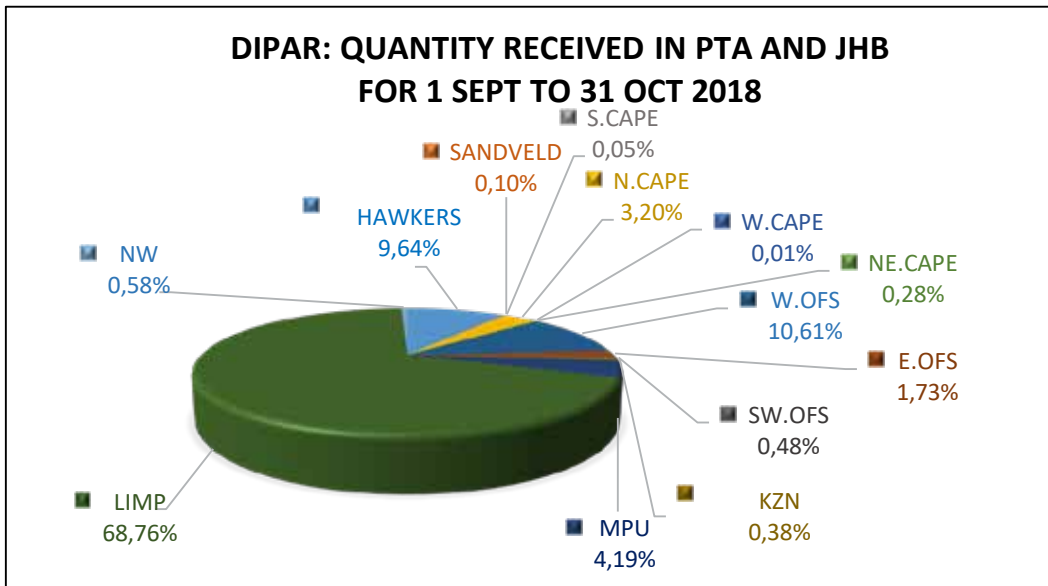
We trust that as from early next year all fresh produce markets will be able to use this system.

- 4.92% were downgraded on average.

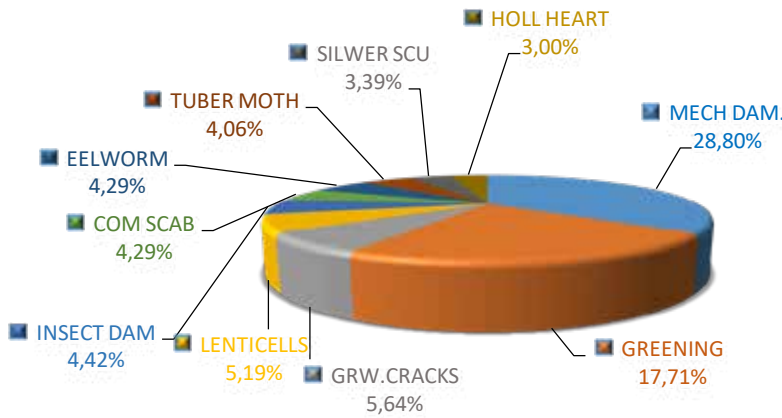

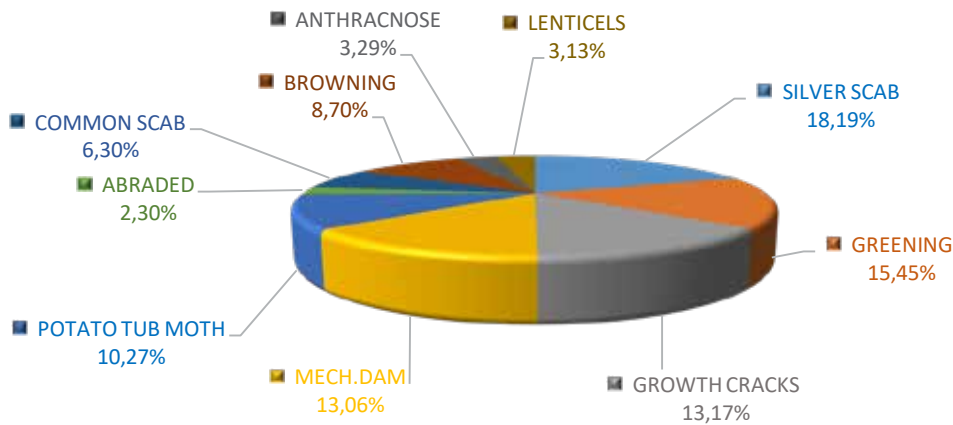
